August Newsletter *Early Voting 2010*

Is voting early more convenient for you than going to the polls? Early voting is an option for ALL registered voters in Pasco County. The utilization of early voting has skyrocketed from 2004 when fewer than 30,000 voters were processed in the General Election early voting period to 2008 where nearly 70,000 voters took advantage of the convenience of early voting. We will offer seven early voting sites in Pasco County for the 2010 Election Cycle. They include: Dade City, Wesley Chapel and New Port Richey Supervisor of Elections' offices, and four libraries (New River, Land O Lakes, Hudson Regional and South Holiday branch libraries). Early voting dates and times for the August primary are August 9th- August 21st and for the November general election, October 18th-October 30th- Monday through Friday 10:00 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

We are proud to announce a new feature added to our website pascovotes.com. You can now check Early Voting Wait Times at each early voting location to avoid long lines and waiting. This feature will be on our homepage during the early voting period.

Early voters are encouraged to view a sample ballot before going to vote. All voters will receive a sample ballot by mail beginning August 5th, and sample ballots are also available on our website, pascovotes.com. From the left-hand side on the homepage, select the Elections link then click Sample Ballots from the drop-down menu.
